

**Herd health visits can be done according to plan, but official instructions must be taken into account.**

- Prior to the herd health visit, it must be clarified that none of the participants (vet, producer, employee) have any symptoms of respiratory disease. If anyone has symptoms, that person is not allowed to participate. If the visit cannot be done without this person, the visit must be postponed. Naseva/Sikava must be informed of such delay.
- Normal guidelines of biosecurity must be followed. The veterinarian must use protective clothing, rubber boots and disposable gloves. Any human contacts will be minimized. Good hand hygiene must be ensured.
- Herd health visits related to handing drugs are considered very important. If the veterinarian gets sick, some other veterinarian that has a contract with that farm can be handing the drugs. If the farm does not have a contract with other veterinarians, the substitute veterinarian can be given this type of rights to Naseva/Sikava.
- Health and welfare of animals must be maintained. Securing production of foodstuffs is very important.
